NOTES

1. Basically in ALPHABETICAL order by first word of TITLE. (“A”, “An”, and “The” are not counted as first words of a title.)
2. Usually listed under title content, not person. (Example: David Ray Griffin: 9/11 and the American Empire)
3. When listed under a person’s name, listed by last name. (Example: Tom Hayden at Roxbury)
4. For both #2 and #3 above—when listed/shelved other than the beginning word of a title—you should see an underline on the part of the title under which it is listed/shelved.
5. [brackets] sends you to where it is listed/shelved.
6. Titles which BEGIN with NUMERALS (e.g. 9/11...; 648 Ways...) are listed and shelved BEFORE the alphabetical list.
7. VHS and DVD formats are shelved in SEPARATE places. That’s one reason why the FORMAT in the listings is important.
8. When checking out one of multiple copies of a title, tell in the LIBRARY Check Out Book which copy you take.
9. When looking for something on a certain subject, check the MOVIE SUBJECT LIST, a separate list.
10. If you find something in our listing that isn’t accurate, or if a Subject should be added, please bring it to our attention. Thanks!

Havana beaches were crowded with rafts, but most of the defectors were routed back to Guantanamo Bay, where some were detained for more than a year before they obtained visas to go to the US. During that time, documentarians Charles Bosch and Josep Maria Domenech followed the progress of seven Cubans as they received visas and job offers, courtesy of the USA Catholic Conference, which promptly scattered the expatriates across their new country. Bosch and Domenech quietly documented the disproportionate expectations of the American Dreamers who imagined Miami and settled for Nebraska. The soundtrack was conceived, written and interpreted by Cuban artist Lucrecia (who lived in Barcelona for many years).
